




Where to look for partners?



Tip 1: Don't waste their time!



European Commission

Tip 2: Understand call conditions and text

SCC1 => specific **eligibility** conditions

Proposals must:

- 1. 2 lighthouse cities $+ \ge 5$ Follower;
- 2. Lighthouse cities cannot be already be funded under H2020;
- 3. Have a validated SEAP, SECAP or equally ambitious plan

Tip 3: avoid common mistakes

Realistic planning

Early identification of critical aspects

Political/regulatory/ changes to be taken into account

Prepare a valuable risk management plan

Pay attention to the template DoA

Dissemination & exploitation plan


