# Pendik Municipality, İstanbul



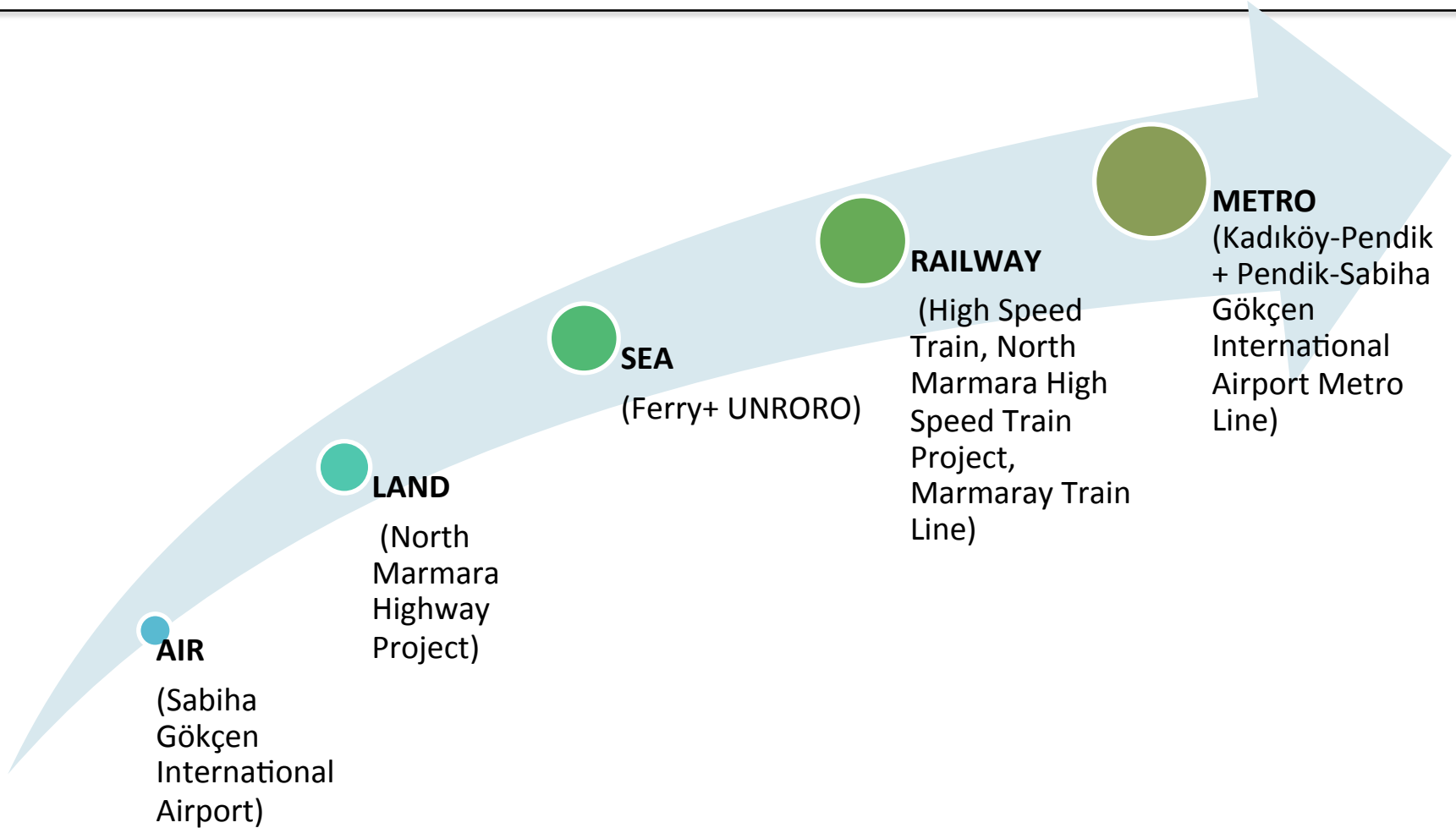
- Pendik Municipality operates at anatolian side of world famous city İstanbul.
