Proposal abstract

- Make it clear, logical and simple for a new reader
- Prepare a draft early, since it is useful to show others, but revise it
- (Usually) start with a statement of what the project will do and include the **goal** and **key objectives**
- Use words to introduce paragraphs clearly (paragraph marks may disappear in the system)







Objectives 1/4

- Describe the specific objectives for the project
- Objectives should be clear, measurable, realistic and achievable within the duration of the project.
- For each objective also record relationship to the call, critical assumptions and time bound
- Objectives should be consistent with the expected exploitation and impact of the project









Objectives 2/4



- The overall objective in terms of the vision Action Plan for the new or upgraded Centre of Excellence including details on the long-term science and innovation strategy of the future Centre
- The Teaming project should be the result of a joint venture
 with a long term horizon of cooperation between the
 relevant partners from both the advanced and low performing
 sides and the provisions for the good management of the
 project between the partners should be specified







Objectives 3/4

Your objectives MUST be in line with call objectives!

- How will you verify that each objective has been met?
- What measures will be used?
- How does each objective relate to the call?

Make clear clasification (if aplicable)

- Long-term objectives
- Short-term objectives

 Opportunities in terms of potential, importance of research field etc. Threats in terms of system threats, financial sustainability etc.

 Clearly identify alignment and complementarity with the relevant Smart Specialisation Strategies of the Member State or region from which the applicant is coming or other high-level European policies or European policies with regional focus


