

- Direct innovation support to SMEs (75 %)
- Complementarities with S3 strategies & other funding

- processes
- marketing methods
- organisational methods
- impact on resource efficiency (water, energy, material consumption)









Figure 1 -Countries where SMEs have received INNOSUP-1 innovation support,



## How can you benefit from Innosup1?

As a partner in the Innosup project providing support for innovation to SMEs

- → EUR 5mln per project (but :75% budget for SMEs innovation support)
- →any legal entity from H2020 countries (min 3 dif. Countries)
- → annual call open in November- deadline April (2 stage)

# As an SMEs receiving support for innovation

- → Up to EUR 60.000 equity free
- → any SME from H2020 can apply that meets the criteria of the call
- → check for all ongoing Innosup-1 projects

## Next call for Innosup-1 proposals



**Call opens** 07/11/2019

EUR 25.15 Mio (EUR 4 to 5 Mio per project)

Deadline (1<sup>nd</sup> stage): 2<sup>nd</sup> April 2020

Deadline (2<sup>nd</sup> stage): 8 September 2020

Number of projects to be funded: 5-6

## The ClusterXchange pilot scheme

Short-term exchanges to foster strategic interregional collaboration to explore new **growth opportunities &** 

#### industrial transformation:

Identifying new partners enhancing market access Supporting networking On-the-job training Sharing experiences Capacity-building activities

#### How is it implemented?

- Matching IT tool/support
- Implemented by cluster organisations of Cluster Partnerships (ESCP-4x)
- Small financial support to visiting organisations (lump sums of max. 1100 EUR)

## Objective:

Overall 500 exchanges
50% involving SMEs
25% other participants beyond
direct beneficiaries
