# How can you benefit from Innosup1?

## As a partner in the Innosup project providing support for innovation to SMEs

- → EUR 5mln per project (but :75% budget for SMEs innovation support)
- →any legal entity from H2020 countries (min 3 dif. Countries)
- → annual call open in November- deadline April (2 stage)

# As an SMEs receiving support for innovation

- → Up to EUR 60.000 equity free
- → any SME from H2020 can apply that meets the criteria of the call
- Check for all ongoing Innosup-1 projects

# The ClusterXchange pilot scheme

Short-term exchanges to foster strategic interregional collaboration to explore new **growth opportunities & industrial transformation**:

> Identifying new partners enhancing market access Supporting networking On-the-job training Sharing experiences Capacity-building activities

#### How is it implemented?

- Matching IT tool/support

- Implemented by cluster organisations of Cluster Partnerships (ESCP-4x)

- Small financial support to visiting organisations (lump sums of max. 1100 EUR)

#### **Objective:**

Overall 500 exchanges 50% involving SMEs 25% other participants beyond

direct beneficiaries
