

Interdisciplinarity, integration of stakeholders' knowledge and enduser involvement ☐ Aims to mobilize additional investments, de-risking investments for private and public sector Public engagement and social innovation, "Leaving no one behind" ■ Not about frontier science, but about using and demonstrating what has been developed so far, links with existing EU initiatives ☐ EGD call will be very competitive, so only proposals that correspond 100% to requirements should be submitted
