Many tools and opportunities to serve common EU policies

- Grants awarded to specific projects. Research projects in climate change, medicine, digitisation, etc.
 Loans, Guarantees, Equity as financial assistance through banks. Guaranteed loans to startups
 - **Subsidies** as financial assistance to specific groups or sectors. Subsidies to Farmers (CAP), support to workers due to covid-19 (SURE)
 - Prizes to winners of contests


















A timeline The process of getting a grant














Innovation Chain From Research to the market














TRL: Technology Readiness


