

Plan S is an initiative for Open Access publishing that was launched in September 2018. The plan is supported by cOAlition S, an international consortium of research funding and performing organisations. Plan S requires that, from 2021, scientific publications that result from research funded by public grants must be published in compliant Open Access journals or platforms.

We have checked and the journal encourages you to freely share <u>your paper</u> so colleagues and the public can freely read and cite it. [1]

√ Find the manuscript the journal accepted. It's not a PDF from the journal site

This is the only version you're able to share under copyright. The accepted manuscript is the word file or Latex export you sent the publisher after peer-review and before formatting (publisher proofs).

√ Check there aren't publisher logos or formatting

It's normal to share accepted manuscripts as the research is the same. It's fine to save your file as a pdf, make small edits to formatting, fix typos, remove comments, and arrange figures.

√ Tell us your email
