





Dünyada, özellikle Orta Doğu ve Kuzey Afrika (MENA) Yeni Nesil Membran Biyoreaktör Sistemlerinin Geliştirilme. ülkelerindetemizsulhtivacı elderekartıyor. Dünyanüfusunun Prolesi tek asamada vüksek kalitede su elde edilmesini % 5'I MENA ülkelerinde yaşamakla birlikte, bu ülkeler temiz sağlamak, yeni nesli bir MBR/NF hibrit prosesinin su kaynaklarının sadece % 1'ine ulaşabiliyorlar. Yağış geliştirilmesini amaçlamak amacıyla başlatıldı. Geliştirilen oranlarının düşük olması ve yenilenebilir kaynaklarından MBR sistemleri sayesinde atık su düşük maliyetle daha fazia su tüketmeleri MENA ülkeleri icin atık suların geri arıtılabilirken, denize boşaltılan suyun Akdeniz'deki kazanımınıdaha önemlikiliyor.
