Truths, myths (and legends...)

- Was for many years considered as THE less important section of a proposal
- Teams were happy to delegate 'someone else' to write it on their behalf
- Cared for too little (: close to absolutely minimum) input
- Usually few lines for individual exploitation and dissemination
- Main endemic disease: generic parts due to excessive and extensive copy-paste
- However: was of *equal importance* to the other parts
- Chances for a change are... good? Same bad as before? Don't know...











New vs old:

- Two sections same as in the old templates:
- 2.1 Project's pathways towards impact [e.g. 4 pages]
- 2.2 Measures to maximise impact Dissemination, exploitation and communication [e.g. 5 pages]









Award Criteria



How Proposals are evaluated

EXCELLENCE	IMPACT	IMPLEMENTATION
 Are objectives clearly identified? Is proposed work is ambitious? Goes beyond the state-of-the-art? Is proposal sound? 	 Is the pathway suggested credible? Are outcome and impacts in line with WP? What's the scale of the contributions? Are measures to maximise impact suitable? 	 Is the WP effective? Are risks identified? Effort assigned appropriate? Capacity and role of participants? Consortium as a whole?











It's all (again) contained in a box...

Impact – aspects to be taken into account.

- Credibility of the pathways to achieve the expected outcomes and impacts specified in the work programme, and the likely scale and significance of the contributions due to the project.
- Suitability and quality of the measures to maximise expected outcomes and impacts, as set out in the dissemination and exploitation plan, including communication activities.











Section 2.1: Project's pathways towards impact

- Again the narratives!
- Provide a narrative explaining how the project's results are expected to make a difference in terms of impact, beyond the immediate scope and duration of the project. The narrative should include the components below, tailored to your project.
 - (a) Describe the unique contribution your project results would make towards (1) the **outcomes** specified in this topic, and (2) the **wider impacts** in the longer term, specified in the respective destinations in the work programme.
 - Be specific, referring to the effects of your project, and not R&I in general in this field.
 - But not only!!!











Section 2.2: Measures to maximise impact - Dissemination, exploitation and communication

Section 2.2: Measures to maximise impact - Dissemination, exploitation and communication (cont'd)

- Golden rule:
- No D, E or C activity that is unconnected to project activities
- No generic D, E and C activities
- Good to understand the difference between D and C not always as trivial
- Concern / worry from the side of the proposers: is it worth to invest on this section?
- Answer is definitely yes!
- The excellence (Section 1) is a means to an end: seize challenges, achieve impacts and effectuate positive changes to the society
- This lies at the heart of *Pillar* 2 ('Global challenges...'), the concepts of *Clusters* and the *Destinations*











Section 2.3: Impact summary

- We already covered this in the first presentation ('Key documents and procedures for preparing a proposal')
- We suggest from this every proposal be it a new one or a resubmission
- It is NOT about Impact only
- *Only* 2 of its 6 parts concern the Impact
- It is not as easy as it seems, needs time and practice
- It is good to be filled out interactively and by a team
- It is *all worth* if you run a workshop to cope with this
