Excellence – aspects to be taken into account

- ✓ Clarity and pertinence of the project's objectives
- ✓ Quality of the proposed coordination and/or support measures including soundness of methodology.











### 1.1 Objectives

- Objectives should be <u>consistent</u> with the expected/<u>identified impacts</u> and DEC of the project
- Describe how your project goes beyond the state-ofthe-art, Indicate any exceptional ground-breaking R&I, novel concepts and approaches, new products, services or business and organisational models.
- Describe the ground-breaking nature of the objectives, concept, trans-disciplinarily considered, innovation potential...











### Objectives

- Overall aim =>Short introductory paragraph answering 5 KEY QUESTIONS
  - Which problem are you trying to solve?
  - What are the policy priorities ?
  - ➤ Is the solution already available?
  - ➤ Why now?
  - ➤ Why you? Are you the best consortium to do this work?
- > OVERALL OBJECTIVES









### **SMART** OBJECTIVES

### specific

- What exactly are you going to achieve?
- Is the objective written in a clear and comprehensible way?

### measurable

 Are there clear indicators or parameters to measure the objective?

### acceptable

- Acceptance of project results by stakeholders?
- Do the objectives provide an acceptable solution to the problem?

### realistic

 Is the objective achievable, given the time and resources committed?

### timely

– When will the objectives be achieved?











## **EXAMPLES - TWINNING**

- Stimulating scientific excellence, widening and strengthening networking connections with the leading EU research organizations in the R&I domain
- Strengthening scientific excellence and innovation capacity of the coordinator and twinning Partners in the R&I Domain;
- Improving possibilities of BIP international funding;
- Raising the scientific quality of early stage researchers in a field of R&I Domain;
- Building innovation management infrastructure, intensive training of staff on the innovation management, IPR, fundraising aspects, and peculiarities of participation in EU FP initiatives.











### 1.2 Coordination and/or support measures and methodology

- Research data management and management of other research outputs: Applicants generating/collecting data and/or other research outputs (except for publications) during the project must provide maximum 1/2 page on how the data/research outputs will be managed in line with the FAIR principles (Findable, Accessible, Interoperable, Reusable).
