All in a picture...

- **Co-programmed**: based on MoUs and/or contractual arrangement
- **Co-funded:** Based on grant agreement between the Commission and the consortium of partners - result from a call for proposals for a co-fund action in the work programme of Horizon Europe
- Institutionalised: Joint Undertakings, or by EIT Knowledge and Innovation Communities

HORIZON-HLTH-2023-DISEASE- 3.06: Towards a European partnership on brain health

A European partnership on Brain Health⁷⁷ is expected in the second Strategic Plan of Horizon

Europe.

 Single-stage

 Action type: CSA

 It shalls ensure a broad geographical representation of European countries and plan

• for inclusion of all main related research initiatives, as well as key organisations and associations. In this way, the coordination action should reflect the 'umbrella' role of the future partnership.











Another example...

HORIZON-HLTH-2024-DISEASE- 3.12: Maintaining the European partnership for pandemic preparedness (CSA for Pandemic preparedness research)

The Partnership is expected to continue to build on existing pandemic preparedness networks, and work in synergy with the Health Emergency Preparedness and Response Authority (HERA).

Action type: CSA

- Hop-On facility (HORIZON-WIDERA-2022-ACCESS-07-01)
- Eager to learn the statistics for participation
- Was exactly the 'dream' of any proposer:













On the other hand...

- European Partnerships need a strategy from the side of the organisations intending to get involved to them
- They need all three: *good*, *deep* and *broad* information on the background, the politics, the policies
- This is not something one may cope with in a weekend or in a month
- The building of many partnerships dates back to several years before
- This is **NOT** a reason to give up at all!
- It is a *good* reason to intensify efforts
- Remember what we mentioned for leaving the comfort zone?
